




What is the Adobe Bluffs Educational Foundation? The Foundation is made up of a group of parent / guardian volunteers (board members and general members), two teachers and the school principal. The Foundation team works together with AB staff to create funding priorities and initiatives. Volunteers chair fundraising events and/or fill essential board member roles for the non-profit organization. Funding approval is based upon feedback of all Foundation members with final approval by majority vote of Board members (chairs and co-chairs of Foundation events).

How the Foundation Raises Funds Our Organization's funding comes from direct donations from our AB community, Holiday Photography Session, Annual Silent Auction, Valentine's Dance, Be Strong A Thon, Yearbook, corporate sponsors and company match. **Every Donation Counts!**

What the Foundation Does The Foundation provides a way for Adobe Bluffs' students to benefit from the power of collective contributions and focuses on larger acquisitions. The Organization funds critical funding gaps and provides resources for safety, health, P.E., music, technology and capital improvement. Parent/Guardian donations to the Foundation provide the *sole source* of Funding for:

- Impact teachers and classroom aides to improve student-teacher ratios and provide small group instruction
- Physical Education teacher to provide all students with enhanced PE classes year-round
- Health & Safety materials hand sanitizer stations, COVID testing kits, health office supplies
- Infrastructure Upgrades water filtration system for water fountains, docucams & over 15 new outdoor tables to promote social distancing and outdoor learning

Where are the Funds Spent? The below graph represents the Foundation funds spent for the 2021/22 school year. We are *already committed to over* \$65,000 *in salaries for the 2022/23 school year!*
